In February 2022, Kootenai County home prices were up 19.1% compared to last year, selling for a median price of \$523,885. On average, homes in Kootenai County sell after 72 days on the market, down 28.0% from last year in February. There were 224 homes sold in February this year, down from 276 last year.





12-month comparison, highlighting current month




Monthly Mortgage Rates

Monthly 30-year fixed mortgage rates






As of 2/15/2022, month/year comparison



Active Listings By Price Range


Year-over-year comparison as of 2/15/2022
